JUSTIFICATION FOR AWARD: During the period of February 23 - December 4, 2001, Mr. Matheny demonstrated exceptional performance while being involved in three flight assists. The first two mentioned below were submitted to the regional office as "Outstanding Flight Assists." On February 23, 2001, Mr. Matheny provided an emergency radar surveillance into the Sugar Land Airport on N1676H (PA-28), who was experiencing the loss of navigational instrumentation and radios in IFR conditions. On November 28, 2001, Clint provided an emergency no-gyro radar surveillance approach to N4221 (C-172) into David Wayne Hooks Airport. N4221 lost his gyroscopic heading indicator in IFR conditions and was unable to fly the Runway 17R Localizer Approach. On December 4, 2001, Mr. Matheny provided an emergency radar surveillance approach into Bush Intercontinental Airport on COA 182 (B737-300) with 46 people aboard. COA 128 had lost all navigational instrumentation in IMC.

AWARD AMOUNT: As described in the Air Traffic Recognition Program, the above contribution of moderate value/limited application, may be recognized with a time off award. Therefore, I recommend that a time off award in the amount of 8 hours be granted.
